SHIPMENTS TO AND FROM SHOW SITE: CARRIERS CAN GO DIRECT TO 2150 SE 17TH STREET, FORT LAUDERDALE, 33316 FOR THE PIER 66 (SUPER YACHT VILLAGE) LOCATION

RATES OF \$1.19 PER KILOGRAM ARE BASED ON THE INBOUND WEIGHT AND DATE/TIME EACH SHIPMENT IS RECEIVED

- ◆ ALL SHIPMENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE DOCUMENTED CERTIFIED WEIGHT TICKETS.
◆ IF MATERIAL DOES NOT INCLUDE A WEIGHT TICKET, SHOW MANAGEMENT AN INFORMA BUSINESS WILL WEIGH MATERIAL.
◆ NO COLLECT SHIPMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

CRATED/CARTONED/PACKAGED/SKIDDED MATERIAL rates include all labor and equipment required to unload shipment, storage at no charge for 30 days prior to set-up time, delivery to exhibit space, handling of empty containers to and from booth area, and reloading of shipment onto outbound carrier at the close of the event.

SHIPMENTS REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING will be handled at the exhibitors risk and will be charged the above published rates plus 50%. Includes, but is not limited to any shipment that is loaded and/or packed in such a manner as to require additional handling, ground loading, side door loading, constricted space loading, designated piece loading, stacked shipment(s) and crates delivered to floating docks weighing in excess of 5,000 lbs each. Includes shipments that are loose and not in crates, cases, boxes, and/or non-skidded machinery without proper lifting bars or hooks.
